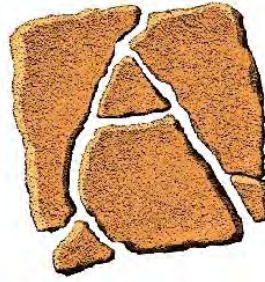

Martha Rodriguez, Kumeyaay-Tipai, potter, basket weaver, artist, and educator, will conduct a class on how to make pottery: from raw clay to the students taking home a small olla.

Lecture to include -

- Martha's description of her pottery collection, letting the class know what to expect for the day; with a video of her mother making pottery, basketweaving, etc.
 - Grind the raw clay, and mix with water.
 - Martha demonstrates how to make an olla.
 - Class members will each make a medium size olla to take home.
- Students need to wear clothes that can get dirty, and bring a bandana to wear to prevent breathing in dust. Students will also need to bring a bucket to mix the clay and then to carry home the damp olla.
