

Volunteer site stewardship on-line training workshop, **May 27, 2023**, 9:00 am to 3:00 pm

This training is the first day of a two-day workshop to train California volunteer site stewards. This free Zoom meeting lasts six hours, including a one hour lunch break. Although there is no cost, you must register at <www.cassp.org>

starting May1. Contents of the on-line meeting include archaeology background, awareness of prehistoric and historic resources, safety, legal protections for archaeology, and Native American concerns.

The second day of the workshop is an in-person, small group, field training that will be offered to those who attended the first day of this or earlier online meetings. It will be scheduled during the following weeks, as conditions allow, at Inyo National Forestand at BLM Ridgecrest Field Office. The second day requires a separate registration, a signed confidentiality agreement concerning sensitive site locations, and a \$25 fee.
